# ACCOMMODATION



The Al Ándalus Train has two types of accommodation.

The Deluxe Suite. A spacious, elegant suite, consisting of a bedroom and private bathroom, perfectly suited for rest and privacy. It features a large bed that becomes a comfortable sofa during the day.

The spacious and comfortable bathroom has a shower, hairdryer and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. A safe, minibar, wardrobe, luggage rack and individually controlled air conditioning are other 21st century comforts that, in this suite, go hand in hand with the

historic train's original appearance. The train features 20 Deluxe Suites.

The Gran Clase Room. This cosy room, which has a private bathroom, features the same size and atmosphere of the original compartments.

It has two single beds that become comfortable armchairs during the day, as well as a minibar, safe, wardrobe, luggage rack and adjustable air conditioning. Its functional private bathroom makes the most of the space, being equipped with a shower, hairdryer and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. The train has 12 Gran Clase Rooms.





# COMMON LOUNGES

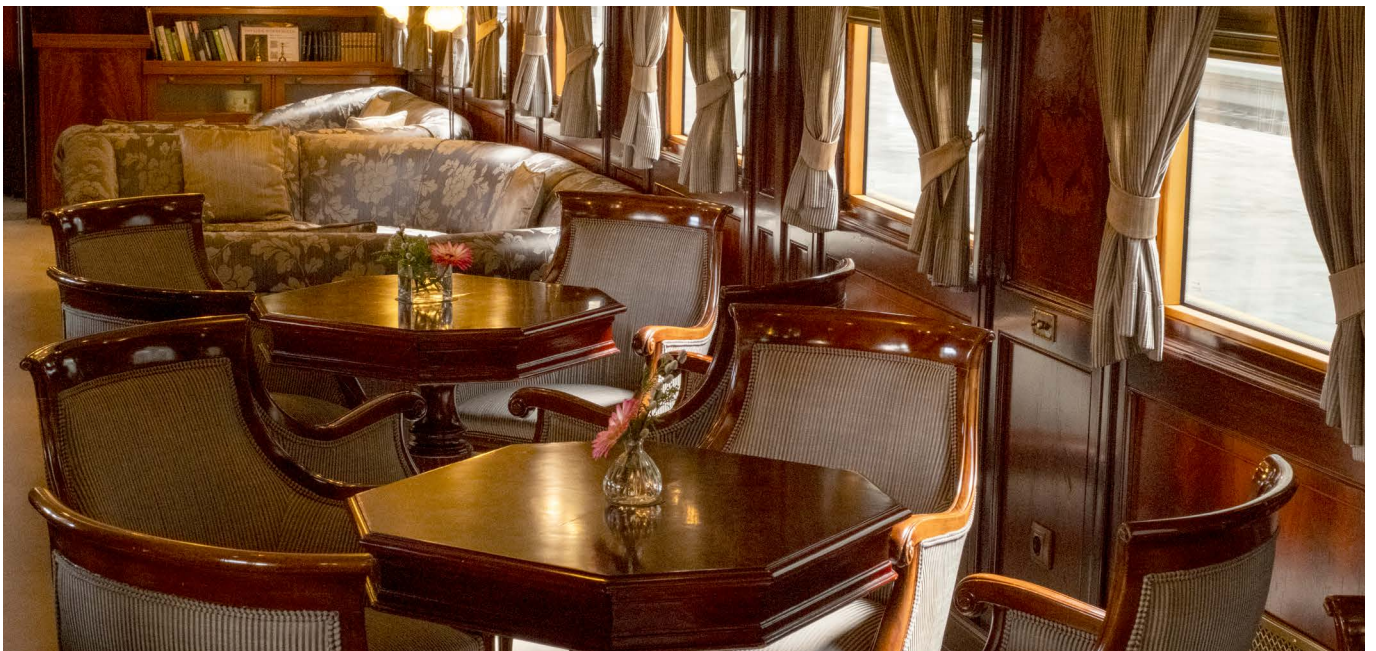


The Al Ándalus Train features four railway gems, its four lounge cars from 1928 and 1930.

These common areas are intended for leisure and the pleasure of travelling on the largest and most spacious luxury train, while enjoying buffet breakfast, lunch or dinner on board, relaxing with a drink, listening to musical performances, contemplating the scenery or simply chilling out in the comfortable armchairs.

All the cars have air conditioning and are open 24 hours a day for your use and enjoyment.

## From Seville to Madrid

### DAY 1: Seville – Córdoba

Reception of passengers at 10:00 a.m. in Seville and tour of the city. Lunch in a restaurant and panoramic view of the Andalusian capital. Welcome toast on the train, introduction of the crew and settling in. Dinner on board as the train heads to Córdoba. Overnight stay in Córdoba.

### DAY 2: Córdoba – Jerez

After breakfast on board, visit of the Mosque-Cathedral and tour of the city. Lunch on board on the way to Jerez. In the afternoon, visit to Cádiz. Dinner at a restaurant and overnight stay in Jerez.

### DAY 3: Jerez – Zafra

Breakfast on board and visit to Jerez, including the show *"How the Andalusian Horses Dance"*. Lunch at a restaurant and visit to a wine cellar. Dinner on board as the train travels to Zafra. Overnight stay in Zafra.

### DAY 4: Zafra – Mérida

Arrival in Cáceres during breakfast and visit to this World Heritage City. Lunch on board on the way to Mérida. In the afternoon, visit to the city and its Roman ruins. Dinner and overnight stay in Mérida.

### DAY 5: MÉRIDA – ALCÁZAR DE SAN JUAN

During breakfast, arrival in Alcázar de San Juan. Visit to an artisan cheese factory and a winery. Lunch in a restaurant. In the afternoon, visit to the town of Campo de Criptana and its windmills. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Alcázar de San Juan.

### DAY 6: Alcázar – Aranjuez

Breakfast on board and arrival in Aranjuez. Excursion to Toledo and visit to its main monuments. Lunch in a restaurant. In the afternoon, visit to the Royal Palace of Aranjuez and its gardens. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Aranjuez.

### DAY 7: ARANJUEZ – MADRID

After our last breakfast on board, we say goodbye to the train and its crew and transfer to Madrid. Guided tour of the city, lunch at an outside restaurant and end of our services at around 16:00 p.m.



# From Madrid to Seville



## DAY 1: Madrid – Aranjuez

Reception of passengers at 10:00 a.m. in Madrid. Lunch in a restaurant. Transfer to Aranjuez and welcome aboard the train. Visit to the Royal Palace and its gardens. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Aranjuez. .

## DAY 2: Aranjuez – Alcázar de San Juan

After breakfast, visit to Toledo and its main monuments. Lunch in a restaurant and free time. Return to the train in Aranjuez. Dinner on board as we arrive in Alcázar de San Juan. Overnight stay in Alcázar de San Juan.

## DAY 3: Alcázar – Cáceres

Visit to an artisan cheese factory and a wine cellar. Lunch in a restaurant and afternoon visit to the town of Campo de Criptana and its windmills. Return to the train and departure for Cáceres during dinner. Overnight stay in Cáceres.

## DAY 4: Cáceres – Mérida – Jerez

After breakfast, visit the historic centre of Cáceres. Lunch in Mérida and tour of its Roman monuments. Dinner on board as we travel to Jerez. Overnight stay in Jerez.

## DAY 5: Jerez

Breakfast and city tour, including the show *'How Andalusian Horses Dance'*. Lunch at a restaurant and visit to a wine cellar. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Jerez.

## DAY 6: Jerez – Cádiz – Córdoba

After breakfast, we will visit the city of Cádiz. Lunch on board on the way to Córdoba. In the afternoon, visit to the Mosque-Cathedral and tour of the city. Dinner and overnight stay in Córdoba.

## DAY 7: Córdoba – Seville

Breakfast on board as we arrive in Seville. Tour of the city and its historic centre. Lunch in a restaurant, farewell and end of our services at around 16:00 p.m.
